OPP Detachment Board – Ear Falls Community Representative

We are inviting applications from community members to join a newly formed OPP Detachment Board starting April 1, 2024, which will be shared with the Municipality of Red Lake.

The Board will be responsible to:

- Ensure the community has appropriate policing to meet its needs.
- Contribute to the safety and well-being of the community.
- Assist in the direction of future policing needs of the community.

The new Joint Board will consist of:

- one elected official from Ear Falls,
- one elected official from Red Lake,
- a Provincial Appointee, and
- two community members (ideally one from Ear Falls and one from Red Lake).

The Township of Ear Falls is seeking applications from Ear Falls residents who would be interested in holding one of the Community Member positions on the Board. This opportunity offers a chance to actively participate in shaping local law enforcement and safety initiatives.

Do you qualify? You must:

- Be an eligible elector in the Township of Ear Falls (although consideration may be given to residents in the region who do not qualify as an Ear Falls elector if there are no qualified applicants)
- Pass a Criminal Reference Check
- Agree to complete the required training and to comply with the Code of Conduct, once appointed to the Board.

As set out in the Community Safety and Policing Act and Regulations, appointees to the Board will receive compensation at a per-diem rate and will be reimbursed for travel mileage to and from meetings. Meetings will be held quarterly, and some special meetings may be required.
